Idea Stage

What is IP?

 Legal right to a monopoly granted by a government entity in exchange for public disclosure, R&D investment, encouragement of creative endeavors and more.

- i. What is the problem?
- ii. Who has it?
- iii. Why is it worth solving?

Problem – solution fit Does it solve the problem?

Product – market fit Will anyone pay for it?

 - → Commercial Product
- Resources
 - Universities

 - Federal, Non-Federal, Industry



IP Details

Patents:

Provisional Patent:

- 1 Year
- Placeholder
- No set format
- **\$500 \$10,000**

Utility Patent:

- 2-6 Years
- Published
- Prosecution
- **\$8,000 \$25,000**

Patent Prosecution:

- United States Patent & Trademark Office
 - Examiner
 - Rejections based on Prior Art
 - Novelty
 - Non-Obviousness
 - Utility and Formality
 - Allowance

Trademarks:

- TM, SM, R
- Last forever if fees paid
- Prosecution with USPTO
- **\$1,000 \$3,000**
- Invalidation through ubiquitous use

Copyrights:

- © WiSys, 2020
- Last 70 years after the death of the author
- US Copyright Office, Library of Congress
- No Prosecution, filing is 2-9 months
- **\$100 \$500**

Issued Patent:

- 14-17 years (20 total)
- Enforcement
- 3 Maintenance Fees

Foreign Patents:

- Prosecute with each country desired
- Expensive
- Follow the Markets
- Enforceability
